## Specific circumstances

**Contrast Nephropathy** 

- A leading cause of hospital acquired ARF ~ 10%
- Definition Increase in creatinine > 25% of baseline within 2 5 days of contrast being given.
- Risk factors
  - Renal insufficiency
  - Contrast osmolality & amount
  - o DM
  - Atherosclerosis
  - $\circ$  CCF
  - $\circ$  Other nephrotoxins

Mechanism – Direct toxicity on renal epithelial cells

Management

- Withhold potential nephrotoxic drugs
- $\circ$  Hydration
- o Isotonic bicarbonate
- o NAC
